





Instructions:

1. Print both sheets out on cardstock. (Trim any excess white margins left by printer.)
2. Cut the first page in half along the dotted line.
3. With the printed side down, fold & crease the bottom half- in half (line up edges) This is your card base.
4. Cut out the top patterned rectangle (with the white circle).
5. Apply a small amount of glue to the back left and right edges of the rectangle. (Leave the top and bottom areas glue-free.)
6. Glue this rectangle to the left side of card, lining up the edges carefully, blank side facing each other. (Trim if necessary.) Allow glue to dry.
7. Next, fold and crease the glued-together-pieces (on left side of card) in half backwards, forming a Z-shaped fold for the card.
8. Carefully cut out the circle, while pieces are folded back in half (you will follow the half circle shape)
9. Cut out both cacti, "Season's Greetings" circle and other accessories.

10. Glue the "Season's Greetings" circle in the center of the right side of card.
11. Cut 8 inches of clear thread, thin thread or fishing line.
12. Center this thread in the middle of a cactus, on the blank side. Glue this in place. At the same time, glue the other cactus directly on top, carefully lining up the edges. Allow this to dry.
13. Carefully open the unglued sections of the top left card, at top & bottom of the circle cut-out space. Place the thread from each end of the cactus through these holes. While keeping thread taut on each end, place a small amount of glue in the holes and press together, with thread inside.
14. For added security, wrap each thread end to the back of card and into back crease. Add some glue and secure thread by pressing crease back together. Allow to dry. Trim extra thread.
15. To cause the cactus to spin, it helps to twist it in one direction several times. Then, close the card and then open it back up.
